th International Data Science Summit held on 19th of February at India Habitat Centre witnessed best of best minds in the field of Data Science, Big Data & Analytics. The summit was conducted by Data Science Foundation (DSF) - a non-profit entity

The summit was supported by Bureau Of Indian Standards (BIS), Govt. Of India. The event witnessed an overwhelming response with delegates coming from

corporates, government sectors and research academia.

The inauguration was done with lamp lighting by Ms Surina Rajan - Director General, Bureau of Indian Standards, Mr. Sudipto Ghosh - Executive Director - Services, Lenovo India, Mr. Wo Chang - Convener of International Standards Committee Working Group on Big Data - ISO/IEC JTC 1/WG9 and Mr. Gautam Banerjee - President, Data Science Foundation.

After the inauguration ceremony, we witnessed an enlightening speech by Gautam Banerjee regarding the journey of Data Science Foundation(DSF) and how DSF is trying to engage different stakeholders of the data science industry in one platform for sharing best practices, understand the challenges and create thought leadership in the space including the focus on creating intellectual properties in the domain. Mrs Reena Garg - Head (Electronics & IT Department) - Bureau of Indian Standards(BIS) enlightened the audience on the efforts of BIS in the standardization efforts of technology in India.

Vivek Pandey - Vice President of Growth & Analytics of Times Internet delivered an address on how to harness big data on the digital media for outreach and rendering customer centric content. Kasturi Bhattacharjee - Senior Director, Group Function Emerging Technologies, IoT -

Ericsson enlightened the audience on data requirements and analytics for emerging IoT ecosystem.

The international standards committee on Big Data Analytics ISO/WG9 meeting that followed next 4 days after the event was critical as well. India national body got support & acceptance in principle from participating countries in the meeting to go ahead with world's first "Business Process Management of Data Analytics" standard for the domain of Data Science & Al after a thorough review. The proposed standard is conceptualized, proposed and led from India by DSF task force members representing different companies like Microsoft, Northern Trust, Honeywell, ANZ, Business Brio, Cognizant under the umbrella of BIS, Govt of India and support of other members from the corporate world.
